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16th FIRST LEGO LEAGUE PHILIPPINES

FELTA Multi-Media Inc. will conduct the 16th FIRST LEGO League (FLL) Philippines (BIOGLOW Season). The season will culminate in the National Championship on February 27, 2027. The organizer will announce the venue of the event.

This season is designed to provide schools, coaches, educators, and learners with a structured journey of learning, innovation, and collaboration. From the official global season launch to the National Championship, participants will engage in professional development, hands-on workshops, webinars, and competition experiences that prepare them for success while inspiring the next generation of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) innovators. The activity aims to

- offer learners new perspectives and opportunities in response to the growing demands of robotics in the local and international landscape;
- promote robotics and STEM education by providing learners with opportunities to develop future-ready skills;
- expand access to robotics learning and strengthen its integration into classroom instruction;
- support inclusive programs for learners, including other underrepresented learners; and
- link robotics projects to local community problems.

The activity is open to elementary and high school learners and will be conducted under the BIOGLOW theme. The categories and corresponding participants are as follows:

Category	Participants	Team Composition
Challenge	Elementary and high school learners aged 9–16 years old	Maximum of 10 members and two coaches per school
Explore	Elementary learners aged 6 to 10 years old	Maximum of six members and two coaches per school

Participation of schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2026, titled Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education and DO 9, s. 2005, titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith, and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.
